## MIXED TEAM COMPETITION

- How?
  - Mixing the medalists of the world championship in 4 or 8 teams in fair teams.
  - Teams will compete in a single elimination
- Categories (ideas)
  - 6x (4x) Fighting (3x m 3x w) a 2 min      Time 24 min (16)
  - 6x (4x) JJ (3x m 3x w) a 4 min              Time 30 min (20)
  - Duo (1 Team)                                      Time 7 min
- Time
  - 60 (45) per "fight"
