Coaches and team leaders are responsible to make sure that all participants are physically fit, prepared and capable to cope with the tournament. We strongly recommend proper medical and accident insurance.

Competitors compete at their own risk.

4 Right to participate and categories:

Based on the JJIF Sporting Code 3.0, Paragraph 3.2. Entries of Competitors:

3.2.2 Maximum Number of athletes per JJNO

For the ADULT World and Continental Championships, each JJNO may enter two (2) contestants in each category, with an overall limit of ten (10) men and ten (10) women in the individual disciplines and no overall limit in the disciplines Duo and Show.

For the Junior World Championships, each National Federation may enter two (2) athletes in each category.

For the JJIF Master World Championships, entries are individual and unlimited

4.1 Categories

Based on the JJIF Sporting Code 3.0, Paragraph 1.3 Disciplines, Divisions and Categories

The age following categories (as described in Paragraph 1.3.2) will be allowed to participate in this event

Name	Description	Year of birth for this event
Masters	Older than 35 years	1984 or older
Adults (+18)	Older than 18 years	2001* or older
U21 (+18-21)	18/19/20 years old	1999 / 2000 / 2001
U18 (+16-18)	16/17 years old	2002 / 2003

*Here the date of birth counts meaning athletes must be 18 at the competition day: No athletes having the age of less than 18 years old will be allowed to participate in the Adults' World Championship of the JJIF. (See Paragraph 1.3.2.)

Official JJIF Weight categories will be used (See Paragraph 1.3.4)

Master:

Beginners: as beginners might register athletes which train Ju-Jitsu, Jiu-Jitsu and any kind of similar martial art for less than three [3] years!

Wrong registration as beginners will lead to disqualification!

Merging of master categories:

Medals will be given in the registered Category. Despite the awarding in the specific registered category the organizer will try to merge categories that bouts contain of more than 5 participants!

150 \$ per fighter - and 150 \$ per duo couple

(85\$ participation / 10\$ Doping Free contribution / 55\$ Referee contribution)

Late entry fees will be apply.

6 Rules and draw:

JJIF competition rules, Organization and Sporting code of JJIF Version 3.0.

We make an appeal to all participants to respect the fair-play and JJIF book of Ethics (actual competition rules are provided also on the official web site of JJIF www.jjif.org.)

6.1 Draw

Based on the JJIF Sporting Code 3.0, Paragraph 4 Draw

The draw en bock will be made before the Coach meeting.

(See Paragraph 4.1. Generalities)

Immediately after draw has been finalized, the drawn categories shall be made available online.

After this, the JJNOs have the right to request minor changes¹ in the following 2 hours or at the coach meeting, but in any case, before the competition starts.

Major changes² must be requested according to the following:

¹ Wrong spelling of names, etc

² Wrong category, etc.



At official international championships, **no redraw** is possible, except for unforeseen cases, when the JJIF Board may decide a redraw.

A redraw can be requested max. 2 hours after the draw was published (or at the coach meeting), but, in any case, before the start of the competition, in writing, to the JJIF Sports Director³. (See Paragraph 4.3. Need for redraw)

7 Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be a doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medication contains any substances on WADA's 2019 Prohibited List (<https://www.wada-ama.org/en/content/what-is-prohibited>)

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE), if it does. JJIF automatically recognizes all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty in applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, please contact the JJIF.

8 Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements

Based on the JJIF Sporting Code 3.0, Paragraph 1.4 Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements

Back Numbers will be send in advance to the national federation to be sewed on the official Gi. Please assure to have correct Gi.

9 Referees

ITO - Referee:

The Organizing committee will take care of the referee working in this event, means **booking of flight and hotel and transportation will be handled and covered by OC.**

Application: Referees can register via in SportsID for the event.
All referee will be waitlisted first.

The Technical Commission (Head referee of discipline) will decide about participation in consideration of Discipline [s], Availability, License level, Evaluation and Ranking, Gender equality aspects, Country. Continental and age mix

Coaches:

All official coaches should receive their accreditation card during accreditation; teams without official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the competition area).

Coaches should attend the briefing meeting.

10 Dress code:

Coaches and Medics coming on the field of play must wear official team dress!
Shorts, Flip-flops, Hats are not allowed. Filming (including mobile videos) inside FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

Coaches must wear suite during the finals / medal fights.

Based on the JJIF Sporting Code 3.0, Paragraph 5 Ceremonies and Awards

Athletes: Athletes on the podium will wear the white competition gi, without any additional materials on their persons (flags, religious symbols, bottles of water, slippers etc.), according to GAISF guidelines.

Every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their medal in person.

11 Advertising

Please note that during the championship no numbers on the back of the Gi are allowed unless specified by the organizer. Numbers on the back of previous tournaments must be removed from the Gi.

Please observe the regulations of the JJIF as far as advertising on the Gi is concerned. See JJIF Sporting Code 3.0, Paragraph 10.7 Sponsor Areas, Patches and Stitching



12 Flags and Anthems

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible of each national federation, must to check flag and national anthem during accreditation process.

13 Financial conditions

Organization of the travel to UAE and Travel expenses and are the responsibility of the participating countries.

The cost of the accommodation and the participation must be paid by each federation to the organizer.

PAYMENT MUST BE DONE BY BANK TRANSER or UP TO 1st of November or take pre approval that you will pay cash at the official registration and accreditation.

15 Appeal and Challenge

Will be applied as defined in JJIF Sporting Code 3.0, Paragraph 1.5 Challenge and Appeal.

For the team competition one negative challenge per discipline will be allowed for the preliminaries and one additional for the medal fights. In this case the accreditation card of the head coach will be marked.

16 Media and TV

The LOC offers FREE TV signal to all JJNO. If you can get an agreement with national/ local TV stations you will get the possibility to use the signal produced by Abu Dhabi TV (all disciplines/ all days).
