Referee course for Jiu-Jitsu (Ne-Waza) continental B license & refreshment:

The participation of the rule seminar is mandatory to participate in the refreshment and examination referee course.

In agreement with the JJIF referee rules the minimum requirements to participate in the exam for continental B license are:

"The candidate must be of a minimum of 21 years of age and have a good knowledge¹ of this discipline. He must have been a referee on a national level for at least one year. He must have refereed at least three [3] competitions in the respective discipline. The candidate must have a good knowledge of English or the language mainly used in this region. Minimum communication ability in the English language is required."

The participation in the seminar together the active refereeing on the German Open can be used to refresh existing Continental and World licenses.

Minimum number of participants: 10 (if there are less than ten registrations at the deadline, we will need to cancel the course and seminar)
