Team managers and coaches of JJIF member federations Subject: JJIF World Championship 2021

Dear Friends of Ju-Jitsu,

As I receive questions about the World Championship 2021 and pick up discussions and rumours at the same time, I like to send you some basic information so you can prepare and be ready.

Everything stated here is related to the CURRENT situation (as of today) and cannot be guaranteed.

We all learned in the last years that things could change very fast, but we are very confident conditions will remain more or less in that frame or even be improved.

We are in final preparations for the Asian Championship (11.-17.09.), the test event for all procedures and protocols. After this, we will publish the final protocol for the World Championship.

- Date and place for the event stay as announced. **29.10. to 06.11.**
Abu Dhabi Jiu-Jitsu Arena (former Mubadala Arena – only the name changed)
- We plan for all disciplines (Jiu-Jitsu, Duo, Show, Fighting)
and all age divisions (U16, U18, U21, Adults, Masters)
- **Registered Participants** (athletes, officials, ITOs, ...) **don't need to quarantine!**
(regardless if vaccinated or not)
- After arrival, you must stay isolated until you receive a negative (arrival) test result.
(typically 5-12h so plan to be in place one day earlier)
- From Arrival in UAE until you leave the competition you must stay in the event bubble:
means: in the official Hotel, official Training facilities, official transport, Sports hall.
- The price for the event package shall not exceed the fees of 2019 (*Hotel Full board \$ 60-90*)
- Daily PCR test required – organized by LOC. LOC will cover costs for the testing
- The LOC will take care of VISA (if you send needed documents in time)
- All athletes are under event insurance which covers possible costs in case of a Covid-19 infection
(Hotel quarantine, Hospital, Treatment).
- Limited numbers of spectators (60%) are allowed in the sport hall
but must prove vaccination and negative PCR test.

For Tourists (Fans, Visitors and spectators), please check <https://visitabudhabi.ae/en/plan-your-trip/covid-safe-travel> for the current restrictions (during the last weeks, most of them were lifted and made more precise!) If you plan touristic activities AFTER your participation, you should leave the “bubble”, change to another Hotel and not merge with the active team and participants anymore.
