3 Liability

The organisers of the event (or any of its officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for any personal injury.

Coaches and team leaders are responsible for ensuring that all participants are physically fit, prepared, and capable of coping with the tournament. We strongly recommend proper medical and accident insurance. Competitors compete at their own risk.

4 Rules and draw

The following rules apply:

- JJIF competition rules (in their latest versions), Organization and Sporting code of JJIF Version 3.1 (OSC).¹
- We appeal to all participants to respect the fair-play and JJIF book of ethics

4.1 Draw modus

The seeding and draw en bock will be made on **Thursday, October 2nd at 20:00 Abu Dhabi²**.

Immediately after the draw has been finalised, the categories will be made available online on the Sportdata Event Website. JJNOs have the right to request minor changes³ in the following 2 hours (from 20:00 to 22:00), in writing, to the organising committee.

Major changes⁴ must be requested according to the following⁵:

- At official international championships, **no redraw** is possible, except for unforeseen cases when the JJIF Board may decide on a redraw.
- A redraw can be requested max. 2 hours after the draw was published but, in any case, before the start of the competition, **in writing**, to the JJIF Sports Director.

Seeding regulations of the JJIF will be observed. For the seeding, JJIF will use the world ranking list and registration to the event from **October 24th 2021**. The JJNOs are responsible for making sure all points are correct in the raking list until this day.

4.2 Appeal and Challenge

Will be applied as defined in JJIF OSC 3.1, § 1.5 Challenge and Appeal.

5 Right to participate and categories

Based on the JJIF OSC 3.1, Paragraph § 3.2. Entries of Competitors:

Each JJNO may enter two (2) contestants in each category for the World Championships.

5.1 Categories

The age following age categories⁶ will be allowed to participate in this event

6 Covid 19 related measures

Please be aware that regulations about entering UAE might change on short notice, and neither JJIF nor UAEJJF can guarantee

These measures will be more clarified in the hygiene protocol of the event, which will be published later.

- Participants (athletes, officials, ITOs, ...) don't need to quarantine (regardless if vaccinated or not)
- After arrival, you must stay isolated until you receive a negative (Arrival) test result (typically, this takes 5-12h so plan the Arrival one day earlier)

From arrival in UAE, you must stay in the event bubble until you leave the competition, meaning in the official hotel, official training facilities, official transport, sports hall, ..., ...

- Daily PCR test required – organised by the local organising committee
- Missing or refusing these tests will lead to exclusion from the event
- The local organising committee will cover by costs for the testing

All athletes are under event insurance which covers possible costs (Hotel, Hospital, Treatment) in case of a Corona infection.

Limited numbers of spectators (60%) are allowed in the sports hall but must prove vaccination and negative test

If you plan touristic activities, you need to do them after your participation at the event. You will then leave the "bubble" and change to another Hotel and not merge with the "active" team and participants anymore.

7 Registration and Participation Fee

7.1 Participation Fee

150 \$ per individual athlete - and **150 \$** per duo/show couple
(85\$ participation / 10\$ Doping Free contribution / 55\$ Referee contribution)

Late entry and late payment fees will be applied.

- Change (of an injured) competitor until registration deadline: free
- Change (of an injured) competitor after registration deadline (in the same category): 10\$
- Change of the category of an athlete: 10\$
- Late entry: 10\$
- Additional entering of a competitor on site: 50\$

8 Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations⁹.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2021 Prohibited List

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognises all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so please contact your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, please contact the JJIF.

9 Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements & Advertising

Back Numbers¹⁰ will be sent in advance to the national federation to be sewed on the official Gi. Please assure to have correct Gi.

Please note that during the Championship, no numbers on the back of the Gi are allowed unless specified by the organiser. Numbers on the back of previous tournaments must be removed from the Gi.

Please observe the regulations of the JJIF as far as advertising on the Gi is concerned¹¹.

10 Referees

The organising committee will take care of the referees working in this event, which means **booking flights and hotel and transportation will be handled and covered by OC.**

Application: Referees can register via SportsID for the event.

All referees will be waitlisted first.

The Technical Commission (Head referee of Discipline) will decide about participation in consideration of Discipline [s], Availability, License level, Evaluation and Ranking, Gender equality aspects, country. Continental and age mix

11 Coaches & Medical personnel from JJNOs

11.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches). All Coaches should attend the briefing meeting (digital) on October 24th).

11.2 Medical personnel

JJNOS may have¹² its medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel the attendance at the medical meeting¹³ is mandatory

11.3 Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses¹⁴, shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation.

According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person¹⁵.

12 Flags and Anthems

The head of each delegation, or designated responsible of each national federation, must check the flag and the national anthem during the accreditation process.

13 Financial conditions

The organisation of the travel to UAE and Travel expenses and are the responsibility of the participating countries.

Each federation must pay the cost of the accommodation and the participation to local the organiser.

Payment must be done by bank transfer until **October 13th** or take pre-approval that you will pay cash at the official registration and accreditation.

No accommodation or registration refund for participants not attending the Championship will be made.
