The top 3 in each category will get a medal and a certificate.

## 1.2. Entry Fee

The entry fee is **10** Euro for each entry.

## 2. Tournament categories

• The tournaments will be carried out in different categories/division, separated by age and sex

- Categories may be split or merged if needed
- Categories are divided into Beginner and Advanced
  - Advanced participants are athletes already competed on national and international level competitions (Grand Slam, Continental und JJIF World Championships)
  - and reached on international level top 5 results or on top 3 results on national level
- Technics selection for presentation:
  - U10, U12 Attacks A1, A2, A3
  - U14, U16 Attacks A1, A3, B2, B4
  - U18, U21, Adults Attacks A2, A3, B1, B4, C2, C4
  - Masters I, Masters II Attacks A1, A3, B1, B3
- The submitted video with the presentation has to be done in the defined order. The scores will be given from 3 judges according to the international Duo rules.

## 3. Registration

## 3.1. Athletes

For registration you need a team / club account on the Ju-Jitsu system which can also be used as an individual account.

Users which already have registered a team / club account, please re-use your account. In this case you can also re-use all your competitor's profiles.

## For registration of competitors please follow these steps:

- Log in with your account
- Check your team data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date
- Enter or update the data of your competitors if necessary.
- In the event calendar search for the eTournament event you want to register for and click on the "Registration" button of the event
- On the registration site you will see the functions to make new entries
- Register your competitors

## 3.2. Referees

For registration of referees please follow these steps:

• Log in with your account

- Check your referee profile data. Please check if the data is correct and up to date.
- Make sure a photo is uploaded and update your data if necessary.
- In the event calendar search for the eTournament event you want to register for and click on the "Registration" button of the event
- On the registration site you will see the function to make your registration
- Register yourself as an eReferee

#### The event is divided into 2 phases:

- Elimination round: 25-27 November
- Semi-finals & Finals: 30 05 November (publishing results 06 December)

You can prepare and record your videos anytime before the upload period starts. Just make sure to follow the video recording requirements.

### The match code for the finals will be provided after the elimination

- One day before the start of the Tournament, the draws will be published, and all participants informed
- A detailed timetable will be published before the start of the tournament on the event page
- Each competitor has to upload and submit the video URL within 24 hours.
- After your submission, your video will be validated in order to make sure it meets all requirements
- Once the videos are validated and approved, the referees will also get 24 hours in order to judge their matches
- This process continues until all the finals are finished on the last day of the Tournament
- Video recording requirements

## 4. Video upload

Each competitor has to upload the video within 24 hours for each round. This gives every competitor the same chance and respects different time zones. In each recording you have to

show the Match Image provide on the event page, in order to verify the recording happened in the correct time frame.

- 1. Log in with your account
- 2. Select the event on your dashboard
- 3. Click on "Open Matches"
- 4. Click on "My Open Matches" and find the match
- 5. Click on the upload icon of the match
- 6. Click on "Upload Video URL"
- 7. Upload your Video or Provide an URL and click on "Test"
- 8. Click on "Submit"
