<b>REFEREES</b>	Only referees who are accredited by their respective countries may participate
<b>REFEREES, DRESS CODE</b>	It is compulsory to use: Dark Blue Tie White short sleeve shirt Dark blue blister Gray trousers Blue / red handle Note: all referees must be of legal age (18 years)
<b>REGULATION</b>	The current regulations of the JJIF will be applied in all modalities and categories.
<b>KIMONOS-GI-UNIFORMS</b>	For the competitors, the use of a white uniform will be mandatory for each of the modalities, it must be clean and in good condition, with a red or blue belt.
<b>RESPONSIBLE FOR DELEGATION</b>	Each Federation will accredit an official Coach and an assistant, a delegate and a person in charge (these may be the same person), along with the registration in the roster, they will ensure the good behavior of their delegation, the delegates will be the only ones authorized to address the Technical table.
<b>THE COACHES</b>	During the match only one Coach will be at the edge of the area located in the chair designated for that purpose, only Coaches registered by the respective federation, no athlete may sit in the coaches' chair, they must maintain a behavior according to this great event, both the referee, the Referees Director and the Championship Director are empowered to call his attention and he may expel the Coach if necessary.

<b>CODE OF CONDUCT</b>	Athletes, coaches, delegates and other members of the delegation must fully respect the JJPU Code of Conduct.
<b>DRESS CODE</b>	Sports uniform or pants and jacket  Referees: Dark blue jacket, white short-sleeved shirt, dark blue tie, blue-red handles and gray pants.
<b>RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SELECTIONS NATIONAL</b>	Each delegation will be responsible for the conduct and possible injuries of its athletes that may occur during the entire period of the championship.

<b>TEAM</b>	<p><b>ADVANCED ADULTS:</b> Each country can register up to 2 athletes per weight category.</p> <p>Adult Rookies (White Belts), Advanced Masters, White Masters, U21, U18, U14, U12, U10, U8, U6 :: There is no limit to the number of athletes per weight division.</p>
<b>ACCOMMODATION</b>	<p>Hotel offered by the Organization:</p> <p><b>Official Hotel</b></p> <p>Single room US \$ 70 c / The three meals. (price per person per night)          Double or Triple room- US \$ 60 c / The three meals. (price per person per night)</p> <p><b>NOTE: IT IS MANDATORY to stay at the official hotel provided by the organization, due to biosecurity issues.</b></p>
<b>RANKING</b>	<p>Participation in the 2021 Senior Pan American Championship in the ADVANCED category, and the results obtained will add points to the official Ranking of athletes of the International JiuJitsu Federation JJIF. You will score points in the categories that will be in the World Games 2022.</p>
<b>AWARD</b>	<p>A medal will be awarded to the 1st. , 2nd. and two 3rd. places by competition category.</p> <p>PANAMERICAN Trophy will be awarded to the teams that occupy the 1st. , 2nd. and 3rd.</p> <p>Place (only the points of the ADVANCED category will be added: FIGHTING, NEWAZA, DUO, TEAMS).</p>

<p><b>MEDICAL ATTENTION</b></p>	<p>The JiuJitsu Colombian Federation will provide all registered participants, emergency medical services during the Championship, in case any medical intervention is necessary such as injury and / or illness that requires hospitalization, treatments, surgical interventions, and medications, the costs must be assumed by the respective National Federation. Therefore, the participating or competitor National Federations will exempt the Jujitsu Pan American Union and the organizing Federation from all responsibility for any mishap that occurred during training and / or competition.</p> <p>NOTE: Each National Federation must bring international medical insurance for each of the athletes in the delegation or insurance against accidents</p>
<p><b>BIOSECURITY PROTOCOL</b></p>	<p>All those attending the Pan American Championship must present a COVID - 19 test with a negative PCR or ANTIGENS result, carried out a minimum of 24 to 72 hours, before the start of the competition.</p> <p>The vaccination certificate must be presented.</p> <p>The use of a mask will be mandatory throughout the competition, only athletes will remove them for their fights.</p> <p>Hand disinfection points will be available</p> <p>The temperature will be taken when entering the competition site</p>
