

ENROLMENT:

All athletes/coaches must be registered **exclusively online** through the Sportdata-Judo website (www.sportdata.org/judo)



If you do not have a Sportdata Club account, it will be necessary to create a new account on the Judo section of the website.



REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

The athletes/coaches must be registered through the Judo section of the *Sportdata* website **before Monday 14**th **of May, 2018**.

FEES & PAYMENT:

COMPETITORS U10 and U12: per athlete € 10,00 COMPETITORS all other categories: per athlete € 15,00

The tournament fees can be **only paid online** via PayPal or Credit Card (GestPay) through the Sportdata website.

The registration deadline is Monday 14th of May, 2018

Please, note that **no refunds will be given** in case of cancellation or non-participation to the event.

COMPETITION ACCREDITATION:

In order to facilitate the smooth running of the event and, consequently, improve participants' comfort, it is required:

- a) To register athletes/coaches, on time, through the Judo section of the Sportdata website;
- b) The registered athletes can directly go to the weigh-in operations, bringing a valid ID/Passport and the Judo License.
- c) Please, note that according to the Italian Federation rules, **Veteran athletes** must compete in the weight category declared at the registration. **If for any reason they do not reach or they exceed the declared weight category they cannot compete. There is no exception to this rule.** However, on Friday 18th of May from 5 pm to 6:15 pm an accreditation desk will be available for the Veterans who want to change their declared weight category before the official weight-in operations. The accreditation desk can be found at Istituto Tecnico Statale "G. Girardi" (please, see page 8). **Please, note that after 6:15 pm of Friday 18th of May the Veterans will not be able to change their declared weight category anymore.**

RULES

CONTEST TIMES:

U10: 1 minute exactly (no Golden Score)
U12: 1.5 minutes exactly (no Golden Score)

U13: 2 minutes exactly (no time limit for the Golden Score)
U15: 3 minutes exactly (no time limit for the Golden Score)
U18: 4 minutes exactly (no time limit for the Golden Score)
U21+U36: 4 minutes exactly (no time limit for the Golden Score)
Veterans (1959 → 1988): 3 minutes exactly (no time limit for the Golden Score)

Veterans (1953 → 1958): 2.5 minutes exactly (+ 1 minute Golden Score and, eventually, hantei)

ATTENDANCE:

All the Clubs affiliate to the FIJLKAM for the current year, or to a foreign Federation recognized by IJF or FIJLKAM, can participate in the "Città Murata" International Judo Tournament.

All participating athletes must be regularly and properly enrolled to FIJLKAM, or to a foreign Federation recognized by IJF or FIJLKAM, for the current year.

WEIGH-IN OPERATIONS:

The registered athletes can directly go to the weigh-in operations, bringing a valid ID/Passport and the Judo License.

Official weigh-in operations and "random" weigh-in check will be carried out according to the attached programme.

Please, note that according to the Italian Federation rules, **Veteran athletes** must compete in the weight category declared at the registration. **If for any reason they do not reach or they exceed the declared weight category they cannot compete. There is no exception to this rule.** However, on Friday 18th of May from 5 pm to 6:15 pm an accreditation desk will be available for the Veterans who want to change their declared weight category before the official weight-in operations. The accreditation desk can be found at Istituto Tecnico Statale "G. Girardi" (please, see page 8). **Please, note that after 6:15 pm of Friday 18th of May the Veterans will not be able to change their declared weight category anymore**.

The declared weight categories of the athletes in the other age classes, if needed, can be changed directly during the official weigh-in operations.

Male athletes will be weighed in underwear; female athletes will be weighed in bodysuit or swimsuit. There will be a 100g tolerance for everybody.

Concerning U10 and U12 athletes, weigh-in operations will be performed exclusively "randomly". Males will be weighed with judogi trousers; females will be weighed with judogi trousers and white t-shirt (with no collar). There will be a 500g tolerance for everybody.

DRAW:

The draw will take place automatically, via software.

The draw for the Veteran age category will be carried out at the Istituto Tecnico Statale "G. Girardi" at the end of the weigh-in operations on Friday 18th May 2018. The draw will be performed according to the FIJLKAM rules and after merging different weight categories when necessary and at the discretion of the Head Competition Director.

The Veterans athletes that will undergo the weigh-in operation in the morning of Saturday 19th May 2018 and will not reach or exceed the declared weight category, will not compete. There is no exception to this rule. Those Veterans athletes who will not present themselves at the "random" weigh-in check or that will not reach or exceed the declared weight category will be eliminated from the completion as well.

Concerning all other age categories (with the exception of U10-U12), the draw will be carried out right after the weigh-in operations of each weight class, according to the Fijlkam rules.

Concerning the age categories U10-U12 the competition will be carried out using the Pule method (round robin), dividing the participants into groups of 3 or 4 athletes that will be as homogeneous as possible. Please, not that the group creation will be carried out in the days before the competition. Therefore, it will be a Club responsibility to communicate the names of eventual registered athletes who will not participate in the Tournament.

COMPETITION SYSTEM:

It consists of knock-out competition with Double Repêchage.

The Poule system (round robin) will be adopted for weight categories in which there are up to 3 (5 for Veterans) athletes.

The use of white and blue judogi is recommended. However, the use of white and red belt is allowed as well.

Concerning the age categories U10-U12 the competition will be carried out using the Pule method (round robin), dividing the participants into groups of 3 or 4 athletes that will be as homogeneous as possible.

REFEREEING:

Referees will be nominated by the Italian Federation of Judo (FIJLKAM) or by its Veneto Regional Committee.

Each fight will be refereed by one Referee on the mat and two Referees at the Video review system (C.A.Re. System).

Current international rules in force for Judo competitions will be applied. In particular, KANSETSU-WAZA and SHIME-WAZA are prohibited for U13 and U15 age classes.

The protected judo rules will be applied for the age categories U10-U12, and a victory will be given after the second Ippon. On a tie match, at the end of the match time, the victory will be given to the most active and positive athlete at the discretion of the referee. The U12 class will start the matches without grips.

In no event or circumstance athletes and/or their representatives can appeal the decision of the Refereeing Committee. No appeal and/or protest against the decision of the Referee will be accepted.

SCORES FOR CLUB CHART:

Clubs will be ranked in two separate ranking list, one for the Veterans age classes and one for the other age classes (with the exception of U10-U12), giving a score to each athlete according to the following table:

1st place - 10 points 5th place - 4 points 2nd place - 8 points 7th place - 2 points

3rd place - 6 points

4th place – 5 points 9th place or below – 1 point

No points will be given to the athletes of the U10-U12 age classes.

AWARDS:

For Veterans competition

Clubs 1st to 3rd place CUP or PLATE

Athlete 1st place Gold Medal*
Athlete 2nd place Silver Medal*
Athlete 3rd place Bronze Medal*

For the other age classes competition

Club 1st place "CITTÀ MURATA" TROPHY

Clubs 2nd to 5th place CUP or PLATE

Athlete 1st place Gold Medal*
Athlete 2nd place Silver Medal*
Athlete 3rd place Bronze Medal*

For the U10-U12 age classes competition Gold Medal* to all the participants.

Trophy, Cups and Plates will be won by the Club that will have the highest number of total points earned by their athletes in both male and female categories.

In a tie situation the prize will be awarded to the Club with more 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and/or 3^{rd} place athletes. If still tied it will be given to the Club with fewer athletes, then to the Club that came from the farthest away.

AWARD CEREMONY:

It is mandatory that all the athletes placed in the first three positions, in their relative weight classes, take part in the Award Ceremony. If this does not happen, the organizers of the "Città Murata" event would have the right to not give the medals to those athletes who, for whatever reason, are not present at the Award Ceremony.

It is mandatory that a delegate for each winning Club takes part in the Award Ceremony. If this does not happen, the organizers of the "Città Murata" event would have the right to not give the prize to those Clubs which, for whatever reason, are not present at the Award Ceremony.

^{*} Medals will be produced in non-precious material and they will be gold-like, silver-like and bronze-like colors.

Milano-Venezia A4 Highway:


Padova Ovest exit, follow signs to Bassano del Grappa – Trento

(North) for about 30Km;



Palasport di Cittadella - Via A. Gabrielli (ex Viale dello Sport)

Once in Cittadella keep on the outer ring road (bear left); when descent from the <u>first</u> overpass take the first exit street on the right, then take Via A. Gabrielli (second left); the Sports Hall is located between the pool and the stadium.

ATHLETES AWARD CEREMONY:

The athletes award ceremonies will take place after the end of the competition of each age group.

CLUB AWARD CEREMONY:

The Club award ceremony will take place each day at the end of the competitions, after the award ceremony of the last age group.

It is **mandatory** that all the awarded athletes attend the Award Ceremony **wearing the white judogi**. Their absence will allow the tournament organizers to not give the medal to the athlete who does not participate in the ceremony.

It is mandatory that a delegate of each awarded Club attends the Award Ceremony. The absence will allow the tournament organizers to not give the prize to the Club who does not participate in the ceremony.

Note: the tournament organizers reserve the right to change the competition schedule if technical times will be shortened or stretched, due to the number of participant.

DISCLAIMER:

Each Club is liable for their own athletes and, in particular, regarding the checking-up of their gender and the status of non-pregnancy for women.

Each Club, in the figure of its athletes's Coach and/or in the figure of its legal representatives, and each referee, are responsible for themselves and for their athletes and they assume full Criminal and Civil liability in case of accidents. In addition, they have to provide all insurance coverage, for the current year, for the athlete who is participating in the "Città Murata" tournament, for the Competition Officials (including referees during competition), thus releasing the tournament organizers from any liability.
