

"Città Murata" 2020 International Judo Tournament

The tournament organization invites your Club to participate in the International Judo Tournament "Città Murata", an individual competition for U10, U12, U13, U15, U18 e U21+U36 athletes, which will be held on

SATURDAY 16th AND SUNDAY 17th MAY 2020

at the Sports Hall of Cittadella (Padova) – Italy

ATTENDANCE:

All the Clubs affiliated to the FIJLKAM for the current year, or to a foreign Federation recognized by IJF or FIJLKAM, can participate in the "Città Murata" International Judo Tournament.

All participating athletes must have an active membership with FIJLKAM, or with a foreign Federation recognized by IJF or FIJLKAM.

ENROLMENT:

All athletes/coaches must be registered exclusively online through the Sportdata website (www.sportdata.org/judo) **before Monday 11th May 2020**.

If you do not have a Sportdata Club account, you can create one on the Judo section of the Sportdata website, link above.

FEES & PAYMENT:

ATHLETES U10 & U12:

payment before 11th May 2020: per athlete **€ 12,00**

payment after 11th May 2020: per athlete € 15,00

ATHLETES all other categories:

payment before 11th May 2020: per athlete **€ 15,00**

payment after 11th May 2020: per athlete € 20,00

U12 TEAM Competition:

payment before 11th May 2020: per Team **€ 60,00**

payment after 11th May 2020: per Team € 75,00

The tournament fees can be only paid online via PayPal, or Credit Card, through the Sportdata website.

The registration deadline is Monday 11th May 2020

Please, note that **no refunds will be given** in case of cancellation or non-participation to the event.

COMPETITION ACCREDITATION:

Athletes who already paid the registration fees and who are no longer on the Sportdata waiting list can proceed directly to the weigh-in operations, bringing with them a valid ID/Passport and a Judo License.

Please, note that according to the Italian Judo Federation rules, U18 and U21+U36 male athletes will be weighed in underwear; female athletes will be weighed in bodysuit or swimsuit. There will be a 100g tolerance.

U10, U12, U13 and U15 male athletes will be weighed with judogi trousers; females will be weighed with judogi trousers and white t-shirt (with no collar). There will be a 500g tolerance.

U10-U12 Draw & Rules

Participants the age categories U10 and U12 the participants will be splitted into groups of 3 or 4 athletes.
2 athletes: Best of three rounds;
3 athletes: Round Robin;
4 athletes: Knock-out plus 3rd place match.

U12 Mixed Teams (2009-2010)
form white (6° Kyu) to brown (1° Kyu) belt
M/F: Kg -38/-41/-44/-48/-52
Contests time: 2' **G.S.:** 1'
Official weigh-in operations: 15:30-16:00 (30')

It will not be necessary to double-weigh those athletes who participate both in the individual and team competition, if this is notified during the first weigh-in operation.

U12 Teams Draw & Rules

Teams will consist of 5 weights (minimum 3), with a maximum of 2 athletes per weight category.
The competition will take place with a minimum of 3 teams.
3 teams: Round Robin;
4 teams: Knock-out plus 3rd place match.
more than 4 teams: Knock-out plus double repechage.

Referee rules specifications

Referees will be nominated by the Italian Federation of Judo (FIJLKAM) or by the FIJLKAM Veneto Regional Committee.

Current international rules in force for Judo competitions will be applied. In particular, KANSETSU-WAZA and SHIME-WAZA are prohibited for U10, U12, U13 and U15 age classes; KANSETSU-WAZA, SHIME-WAZA and SUTEMI-WAZA are prohibited for U10 and U12.

In no event or circumstance athletes and/or their representatives can appeal the decision of the Refereeing Committee. No appeal and/or objections against the decision of the Referee will be accepted.

U13 - U15 - U18 - U21+U36 Draw & Rules

2 athletes: Best of three rounds;
3 athletes: Round Robin;
4 athletes: Knock-out plus 3rd place match.
more than 4 athletes: Knock-out plus double repechage.

Draws will be carried out right after the weigh-in operations of each weight class, according to the Fijlkam rules and with no seeded athletes.

Scores & Awards

Clubs will be ranked in two separate ranking lists, one for the individual competition and one for the team competition, giving a score to each athlete according to the following table:

1st place - 10 points
2nd place - 8 points
3rd place - 6 points
4th place - 5 points
5th place - 4 points
7th place - 2 points
9th place or below - 1 point

Points will be given to ALL the athletes who participate in the individual competition, except to who are alone in their category (no points will be given to them).

AWARDS:

Individual competition

Clubs 2 nd to 5 th place	CUP or PLATE
Athlete 1 st place	Gold Medal*
Athlete 2 nd place	Silver Medal*
Athlete 3 rd place	Bronze Medal*

For the U10-U12 age classes competition a Gold Medal* will be given to all the participants.

Trophy, Cups and Plates will be awarded to the Clubs that will have the highest number of total points earned by their athletes in both male and female categories.

In a tie situation, the prize will be awarded to the Club with more 1st, 2nd and/or 3rd placed athletes. If still in tie, it will be given to the Club with fewer athletes, then to the Club that came from the farthest away.

Athletes of 1 st place team	Gold Medal*
Athletes of 2 nd place team	Silver Medal*
Athletes of 3 rd place team	Bronze Medal*

* Medals will be produced in non-precious material and they will be gold-like, silver-like and bronze-like colors.
