PARTICIPANTS

Combined commands from different countries, regions, and sporting clubs are allowed. Competitor's age is determined by date October 12, 2019. The amount of competitors in team is unlimited. Up to 10 team members -1 coach accreditation; from 10 to 15 - 2 coaches; over 15 - 3 coaches. The following documents are required and should be provided on Mandates Commission: an application in a given form, an identification card (identifying participants and their age), the insurance policy, photo. All the participants, including the representatives, coaches, judges, referees and VIP's should be registered at www.sportdata.org and post their photos there.

EQUIPMENT

Equipment of all participants should comply with WKF rules.











REFEREES

Qualified referees and judges are welcome. All referees will be provided with meal during the tournament. Referees will be paid for their work.

PROTESTING

The deposit for considering the protest is 100 EUR.
