Boys:

- ✓ 8-9 years old Basic Kata: Heian, Pinan, Gekisai 1-2. Can be repeated.
- ✓ 10-11 years old Basic Kata: Heian, Pinan, Gekisai 1-2. Can't be repeated.
- ✓ 12-13 years old 1st round basic Kata: Heian, Pinan, Gekisai 1-2.
In other rounds Tokui Kata. Can't be repeated.

Category with less than four players is combined with another category.

Girls:

- ✓ 8-10 year old Basic Kata: Heian, Pinan, Gekisai 1-2. Can be repeated.
- ✓ 11-13 year old 1st round basic Kata: Heian, Pinan, Gekisai 1-2.
In other rounds Tokui Kata. Can be repeated every third time.

Category with less than four players is combined with another category.

Individual KUMITE

Boys:

- ✓ 8-9 years old -27, -35, +35 kg 1 min., difference 2 IPPON
- ✓ 10-11 years old -30, -40, +40 kg 1,5 min., difference 2 IPPON
- ✓ 12-13 years old -40, -50, +50 kg 1,5 min., difference 2 IPPON

Category with less than four players is combined with another category.

Girls:

- ✓ 8-9 years old -30, +30 kg 1 min., difference 2 IPPON
- ✓ 10-11 years old -35, +35 kg 1,5 min., difference 2 IPPON
- ✓ 12-13 years old -45, +45 kg 1,5 min., difference 2 IPPON

Category with less than four players is combined with another category.
