



GBGS Division Conditions

To qualify for Rookie Divisions

- A competitor in their first full season / year of competing.
- No prior Sport Martial Arts competitive experience.

GB Grand Slam reserves the right to withdraw anyone they deem inappropriate to compete in the Rookie Divisions.

All Grade Advance Divisions

- A non-Rookie competitor.
- A category for competitors development and improvement.
- Best of the Best seeding.

Further Division Conditions

Competing once at an event constitutes a competitors first year of competing.

A Pee Wee competitor can compete in the Rookie and Advance Divisions in their respective weight.

A Rookie competitor can compete in the Advance Divisions in their respective weight.

Particulars only for Advance Divisions

Seeding

In advance all grade divisions competitors will be seeded in relation to their podium results at major championships in 2018.

Martial Arts style grades or time training are irrelevant to the GB Grand Slam Divisions. However, 'GB Grand Slam reserves the right to withdraw anyone they deem inappropriate to compete in the Rookie Divisions'.

NB

Referees & Officials will be briefed to inform the Grand Slam Chief Referee if for reasons in the interest of safety or fair play a competitor is unsuitable in the Rookie Divisions. Further action will then be taken.

GB Grand Slam is a Pre-registration only event. A competitor can only change division if at weight control they require to do so. Or if a division does not contain enough starting competitors.
