VERY IMPORTANT NOTE

Each national kickboxing federation (NKBF) should contact and co-operate with the National University Sports Association (NUSA) in the shortest time and agree on further cooperation and communication regarding the participation of kickboxers at the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019

Each NKBF will, in cooperation with the NUSA, determine how the qualifications will be held. At national university qualifications in the foreseen disciplines and categories, students come as representatives of their faculties and as such they are running for appearance in the composition of their university sports team.

Qualifications can be held as separate qualifier tournaments for the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 or qualifications as part of national kickboxing championships - depending on the agreement between NKBF and NUSA.

NKBF will, in cooperation with the University Sports Federation and the NUSA, determine which kickboxers have acquired the right to participate at the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019.

Each University can register an unlimited number of kickboxers in a each category. Double start is possible in point fighting and light contact. On the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 can participate kickboxing teams from all the Universities from each country - WAKO members. On EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 kickboxing teams represent University (not country or national team).

Referees

Referees for EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 will be nominated by WAKO Europe Referee Committee - total 24 referees. Costs of travel and accommodation of referees will cover WAKO Europe and NKBFs.

THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE

The right to participate on the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 has students who meet the following criteria:

- They study at any University of the European countries regardless of degree of study
- They are studying at a faculty that is part of a university, regardless of whether the institution is public or private
- Former students who graduated in the academic year 2017/2018.
- Students who are between 17 and 30 years of age

The right to participate on EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 have kickboxing teams from all of Europe's Universities operating in Europe regardless of whether they are EUSA members or not. The kickboxing team or kickboxers is entitled to participate only who are members of the NKBF who are members of WAKO Europe.

GENERAL ENTRY

This procedure may vary from country to country and should be defined by agreement between NKBF and NUSA.

A student - kickboxer who wishes to participate at the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 must contact the NKBF and the Student sports association the faculty / university where the student is studying. It is also possible for NKBF to report its members to a particular University Sports Association. In the event that the University does not have a student sports association, the student must contact the sporting person at the faculty / university where he or she is studying and NKBF.

After the University agreed and declares that the student - kickboxer or University kickboxing team will represent the University of the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 in kickboxing, the same through his student sports association or by a sports person sends a request to the NUSA to apply for the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 in kickboxing.

NUSA applies to the University Sports Team and to the EUSA online registration system. The system automatically sends a confirmation to the University that it has been registered for the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 in kickboxing and generates a deposit account in the amount of 200.00 €. After entering the general application, the person in front of the University receives user data and instructions for accessing the EUSA online registration system. Until the payment of the deposit the application is not deemed valid and cannot be resumed by entering a quantitative and nominal application.

The deadline for submitting a general application and payment of the deposit is 6 months before the start of the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 - January 31 2019.

QUANTITATIVE ENTRY

After the payment of the deposit, the tag "approved" is displayed in the system and can be continued with a further application process. After the general application, all entries are entered by a person appointed by the student sports association of the University or by a person in charge of sports at the Faculty / University. The quantitative application lists the number of persons (athletes, coaches, officials, judges). The system automatically generates an invoice in relation to the number of registered persons in the amount of 50 % of the total costs that must be paid in order for the quantitative application to be accepted.

The deadline for submission of quantitative applications and payment of 50% of total costs is 3 months before the start of EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 - April 30 2019.

With respect to the above deadline, qualifying competitions and tournaments in the NKBF must be completed no later than mid-April 2019, and in order to qualify for quantitative registration by April 30 2019.

INDIVIDUAL ENTRY FORM

After paying 50% of the total cost, the tag "approved" is displayed in the system and can be continued with a further application process. All details of the participant are entered in the nominative application. After completion, the system generates a "Certificate of Academic Eligibility" that is verified at the University. By verifying that document it is confirmed that the student - kickboxer is eligible to participate in the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019. The system automatically generates an account containing the total cost less the deposit and 50 % of the total costs paid with the quantitative application.

The deadline for filing a nominee application and paying the remaining costs is 1 month before the start of the competition - June 30 2019.

TRAVEL PLAN

The deadline for submission of a detailed travel plan - date and time of arrival and departure, via the EUSA online registration system, is 1 month before the start of the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 - June 30 2019. The organizer is obliged to transport from the bus and train station and the airport to arrive and leave only for those who submitted the plan times.

ACCREDITATION

In order to obtain accreditation, participants must submit at the arrival:

- Confirmation of payment of all costs
- Certificate of Academic Eligibility or a copy of a diploma for students who have graduated
 Valid personal document (passport or identity card)

COSTS

The prize for the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 is 325,00 € per person.

EUSA registration fee is 30,00 € per person (the fee is paid before the participation, via the invoice generated by the system based on the number of registered persons).

The participants themselves bear the costs of medical, travel and other insurance.

NOTES

- The deadlines for registration may be changed in certain circumstances as decided by the organizer and EUSA.
- In each account generated by the system, payment information is provided and payable.
- Every university must report an official to the team, it is not possible for athletes representing a University to perform on their own.
- There is no way to sign up if the University does not want to apply to your student for competition or if the application is not submitted through the EUSA online registration system.

ARRIVALS

The traffic structure of the capital city of Croatia, Zagreb enables fast and safe arrival of the EUC 2019 participants by land, railway or air traffic and easy organization of the participants' transportation at the time of their arrival and departure, during the sports competitions and during participants' free time. Traffic terminals where the arrival and departure of the EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 participants is expected:

Zagreb Airport

The construction of a new terminal enables the receipt of up to 5 million passengers a year. Zagreb Airport "Franjo Tudjman" is the main air traffic centre in this part of Europe. By regular daily direct flights with major airlines Zagreb is connected with whole Europe.



Main railway station in Zagreb

The main railway station in Zagreb is the largest railway terminal in Croatia. The national railway company "Hrvatske zeljeznice" is characterized by the favorable traffic position and by the integration of their rail network in the European railway network.



Bus terminal Zagreb

The bus terminal in Zagreb is the biggest and most modern bus terminal in Croatia facilitating fast and safe transport of passengers to all destinations in Croatia and to all major European cities.



ACCOMODATION

Competitors and coaches: University campus "Stjepan Radić", Zagreb (2600 double rooms)

Officials and referees: Hotel "Panorama", Zagreb (240 single, 44 double rooms)

Accommodation will be provided in the University campus "Stjepan Radic". Total reconstruction of pavilions was finished in December, 2015 and reconstruction of catering facilities was finished in year 2017. The rooms are mostly double with certain number of single rooms. Within the University campus "Stjepan Radic" on disposal are 2 restaurants, pizzeria, cafeteria and a confectionery with a big terrace where catering for EUSA Combat Championships - Zagreb, Croatia 2019 will be served.





The services available for participants in the Athletes' village are laundry service, gyms, meeting rooms, massage room, sport and fun zone, grocery store, ATM, info point, etc.

Accommodation

- Working hours (0-24)
- Persons per room (2 or 1)
- Exchanging towels, bed linen and room cleaning (on demand)
- Room standard (two towels, toilet paper, soap, blankets, pillows, bed sheets, closets, table, chairs, refrigerator)
- Internet (wi-fi and cable free of charge)
- Additional services (daily housekeeping, daily collection of waste disposal, daily maintenance service at disposal)
- Additional rooms (meeting rooms, lounge zone, gym, offices, massage room)
- Info point, security service and medical assistance available 0-24
- Laundry service within Village
- Accommodation rules will be published in every room (penalty in case of damage)

EUSA and WAKO representatives and referees

Four Points by Sheraton Panorama**** is basically located in the center of town. It offers superb accommodation with magnificent view on Zagreb. Hotel has on disposal 280 rooms including 51 suite, equipped with 32" and 42" flat screen TV's. It offers free fast broadband connection to the Internet and the use of its business center. Hotel offers you seven multifunctional conference rooms of various sizes on a total of more than 1100 m² conference space. Catering for the EUSA Family and referees will be provided in special VIP restaurant in University Campus "Stjepan Radic".



FOOD

Breakfast and dinner - student restaurant "Stjepan Radic" / hotel restaurant "Panorama"
Lunch - depending on the daily schedule or in the student restaurant or lunch packs in the sports hall

Catering

- Three meals per day and lunch packages on request
- Restaurants working hours will be confirmed upon completion of sport schedule
- Self-service system for athletes, volunteers and team officials; served food for referees, EUSA EC & TD and VIP guests in separated zone
- Each participating team/individual starts with lunch or dinner, depends on their arrival and ends with breakfast on their departure day

TRANSPORT

Transportation services from/to official welcome points during official competition days will be provided free of charge for all participants. The transportation from/to competition venue, training venue, catering and opening ceremony venue will not be needed thus all four facilities are in radius less than 100m from accommodation facilities.

Which form of transportation will be used during EUC depends on the target group of participants, frequency and duration of the journey, the flexibility and type of the means of transportation.
