CHAPTER 2 Tournament Information

DOPING-FREE TOURNAMENT

GAMMA believes in a doping-free sport. Athletes are bound and must comply with the GAMMA Antidoping rules which are compliant with the World Anti-Doping Code.

These rules will be communicated separately.

ANTI-DOPING TEST

We will conduct in-competition doping testing during the tournament. Athletes will be selected in random according to the International standard procedures and the tests will be overseen by the GAMMA Medical Committee in cooperation with the International Testing Agency (ITA).

To ensure independence, ITA will perform the sample collection and conduct laboratory analysis in accordance with the International Standard for Testing, the International Standard for Laboratories and the 2021 Prohibited List.

During the period of the tournament, athletes can be tested at any time or place with a blood or urine sample with no prior notice. It is each athlete's responsibility to ensure that no prohibited substance enters his or her body.

Entry fee

The entry fee per athlete is **USD 75** including a PCR test that costs USD25 upon departure.

All fees are due upon arrival.

Accommodation and meals up to 10 athletes and two (2) coaches per participating federation will be paid for by the Organising Committee¹ and anything above that will be under the costs of the participating federation. If a country sends less than five (5) athletes, the Organising Committee will cover the accommodation and meals of only one (1) coach.

PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY

Participating Federation must be a full or provisional member of GAMMA.

No more than two (2) athletes from the same country are allowed in a category. If both athletes win all their matches, they will meet in the semi-finals. No athletes from the same country will meet in the finals.

¹ The organising committee pays for accommodation and meals only for athletes and coaches from 24 to 29 August (5 nights). Other participants of the Championship are responsible for their own expenses.

There will be two separate divisions:

Mixed Martial Arts

Striking MMA

WEIGH-INS

All athletes will have their weight measured on the first and second day of the tournament and athletes who are competing on that particular day will also have their weight recorded.

Athletes will be selected for hydrated weight and anti-doping testing based on random sampling.

DRAW

The official draws will be conducted by the GAMMA Organising Committee.

Competitions are held according to the Olympic System with two (2) third places, in eight (8) male weight categories and seven (7) female weight categories.

As no athletes from the same country are allowed to meet in the finals, the two same country athletes will always be on the same side of the draw.

TOURNAMENT VENUE


The championship will take place at two facilities located in Cholpon-Ata town of Issyk-kul Region, Kyrgyz Republic:

FIELD OF PLAY



MATCH DECISIONS

Single Elimination Format following GAMMA International Rules & Regulations, which can be found in the download section when registering on SportsData, GAMMA's event management platform.

In the event of a bout dispute, all decisions made by the Chairman of the Referee & Judges Committee will be final.

MEDICAL

Cholpon-Ata is a touristic town and the access to the local hospital will be available 24/7 during Championship period. Ambulance will be available at the tournament venue.

GENERAL INFORMATION - KYRGYZSTAN

Kyrgyzstan is a landlocked country in Central Asia. It is farther from the ocean than any other country in the world. It borders Kazakhstan, China, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. Mountains cover over 80% of the country. Bishkek is the capital of the Kyrgyz Republic.



The competition venue will be at Cholpon-Ata, Issyk-Kul, Kyrgyzstan. The distance between Bishkek and Cholpon-Ata is 264 km.

AIRPORT TRANSFER

The **Manas International Airport** near Bishkek is the main international airport, with services to Moscow, Tashkent, Almaty, Urumqi, Istanbul, Baku, and Dubai.

Delegations may arrive earlier and depart later. Please send an email to <u>gammakyrgyzstan@gmail.com</u> about the arrival of your delegation by sending a detailed letter indicating the country, name of participants, flight number, date and time of arrival and departure.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation from **Bishkek Manas International Airport** to Resort is about 280 km, around four hours' drive through a beautiful mountain gorge - Boom. Buses and minivans will take delegations directly from the airport to the accomodation and meals on the way, will be arranged.

Minivans will be provided if transportation from **Tamchi Airport** to Cholpon-Ata is required. The drive will take about 30 minutes.

Should delegates wish to travel on their own, the average cost per taxi is around 7000 kyrgyz soms (USD 85) to reach Cholpon-Ata and/or the resort (the distance between Cholpon-Ata and the Resort is about 25 km. The recommended taxi to take is Manas Taxi, where the office is located on the first floor of the airport or download the app called Yandex, which is the Russian version of Uber.

During the entire duration of the tournament, there will be buses and minivans to ferry athletes and their accompanying delegation from the resort to the tournament venue and vice versa.

There will be a schedule for transport timings which will be shared on the day of arrival.





CURRENCY

The local currency used is Kyrgyzstani som, KGS and the easiest currency to exchange is the USD 1 USD - about 84,5 KGS.

LANGUAGE

Kyrgyz is the state language of Kyrgyzstan. Russian is additionally an official language. Kyrgyzstan is one of four former Soviet republics to have Russian as an official language, along with Russia, Belarus, and Kazakhstan.

PLACES OF INTEREST

Issyk-Kul Lake

One of the largest and deepest lakes in the world. Due to its massive size and slight salinity, it never freezes in the winter either, a phenomenon that actually contributed to its name. The word Issyk Kul means "hot lake" in Kyrgyz language.





Ala-Kul

Trail to Ala-Kul is one of the most famous hikes in Kyrgyzstan. This trek has it all: mountain passes, dense woods, waterfalls, yurt stays, and a lake that contains quite possibly the most beautiful water in the country.

Local Market

Local markets are probably one of the best places to visit in Central Asia. Every bigger city has one and you can find pretty much everything there. From local food products to fresh produce to clothes, toys, washing products, and toiletries. One of the famous markets in Kyrgyzstan is **Osh Bazaar in Bishkek** (The market is closed every Monday of the month).







FOOD

Try Beshbarmak: A mix of meat, broth, and noodles. It is a national dish among nomadic Turkic peoples in Central Asia and Russia. Its name means "five fingers: as the dish traditionally is eaten by hand.







WEATHER

Lake Issyk-Kul is surrounded by mountains, so the weather is usually sunny, but rapidly changing. It rains at times, and in the evenings after sunset the sun gets chilly. We recommend bringing your outerwear with you.

Average Weather in August in Cholpon-Ata Kyrgyzstan:

Daily high temperatures from 22°C to 24°C, rarely falling below 17°C or exceeding 28°C. Daily low temperatures from 10°C to 13°C, rarely falling below 6°C or exceeding 17°C. For reference, on August 4, the hottest day of the year, temperatures in Cholpon-Ata typically range from 13°C to 24°C.

ACCOMMODATION

All athletes and coaches will stay at the Solemar Resort, located in Korumdy village, Issyk-kul region, which is 25 minutes' drive from the Tournament Venue.

Solemar Resort consists of separate lodges, which is ideal for COVID-19 safety protocols. Meals are served at the dining area.

MEALS

Meals will be provided three times a day. Breakfast and dinner will be served at the resort and lunch will be provided at the Tournament Venue.





VISA SUPPORT

A list of countries in which visas are not required can be found in Appendix 1. Countries not listed will require visa support.

The list of athletes-is to be provided by July 20, 2021 so that the organising committee has enough time to provide visa support.

<u>Required documents for visa support include³:</u>

- 1. A copy of passport in good quality (two pages with basic information and photo);
- 2. Phone number and email;
- 3. 3x4cm color photo on white background;
- 4. Letter from the country's federation confirming the participants' names. One letter for all members of delegation is enough;
- 5. Purpose of arrival.

Please provide us with all necessary contact information of the head of delegation and/or deputy for communications purposes.

The cost of a visa is approximately USD 75, depending on the country of arrival and the length of stay in Kyrgyzstan.

The visa fee is paid by bank transfer to the account of the visa department. Payment details will be sent after the receipt of the application for the provision of visa support.

COVID-19 TESTING

Entry to Kyrgyzstan: A **negative PCR test** (on paper or electronic) in Russian or English **from no more than 72 hours before your arrival by air is needed for foreign citizens to enter Kyrgyzstan**. If your journey is delayed and your results are outside the 72 hour period you will need to have a further PCR test on arrival.

Vaccinated travelers are exempt from taking the PCR test upon arrival and departure as long as they produce a document which proves that they have been vaccinated with notarized translation into English or Russian.

Requirements could change at short notice. Check with your airline before travelling.

For any questions on entry or exit requirements you should contact the relevant Kyrgyz authorities on +996 312 881 618

Passengers may have their temperature tested on arrival. However, if you're showing symptoms of Coronavirus you may be taken to state medical facilities. You're likely to be subject to temperature checks, and other medical observations on arrival, and could be asked to self-isolate at home.

On Departure From Kyrgyzstan: The organising committee will arrange for all members of the delegation a PCR test to be taken at the resort one day prior to departure at Solemar Resort.

For guests in other resorts, stationary laboratories of the AquaLab network are also available in Cholpon-Ata. The results of the PCR test will take a day for it to be ready and guests should ensure they take the PCR test in advance. Results will be delivered via email, and include a QR-code to verify the authenticity of the test results.

The cost of the PCR test in the laboratories of the AquaLab network is 1,700 KGS (USD20).

Closer to the date of the Championship, the organising committee will do its best to arrange mobile test stations at several resorts for guests' convenience.
