ABOUT SARAJEVO

Sarajevo is the capital and largest city of Bosnia and Herzegovina, with a population of 555,210 inhabitants. Sarajevo is the political, social, sports and cultural center of Bosnia and Herzegovina, a prominent center of culture in the Balkans, with its region-wide influence in sports, entertainment, media, fashion, and the arts.

Due to its long and rich history of religious and cultural diversity, Sarajevo is sometimes called the "Jerusalem of Europe". It is one of only a few major European cities which have a mosque, Catholic church, Orthodox church and synagogue within the same neighborhood.

Although settlement in the area stretches back to prehistoric times, the modern city arose as an Ottoman stronghold in the 15th century. Sarajevo has attracted international attention several times throughout its history. In 1885, Sarajevo was the first city in Europe and the second city in the world to have a full-time electric tram network running through the city, following San Francisco. In 1914, it was the site of the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand of Austria by terrorist Gavrilo Princip sparked World War I.

After World War II, the establishment of the Socialist Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina within the Second Yugoslavia led to a massive expansion of Sarajevo, the constituent republic's capital, which culminated with the hosting of the 1984 Winter Olympics marking a prosperous era for the city.

However, after the start of the Yugoslav Wars, for 1,425 days, from April 1992 to February 1996, the city suffered the longest siege of a capital city in the history of modern warfare, during the Bosnian War and the breakup of Yugoslavia.

But after the bad years always comes the sun and progress.



1.1. Dates

The 34-th Senior and 25-th Junior European Taekwon-Do Championships will be held on 10th – 13th October 2019 in Skenderija Sports center, Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina. Delegations must arrive in Sarajevo before or on Wednesday, October 9th, 2019 before 14:00 hour and must proceed directly to the meeting point Hotel Holiday **** for registration and payment.

1.4. Competition application and participation fees:

1.4.1. This competition is open only for AETF affiliated countries and the registration will be done only through the online registration website available.

- The registration will be done only online and it will be closed on **September 30th 2019 at 23:59.**

1.4.2. Entry fees:

- Individual – 100,00 EURO per competitor;
- Team – 50,00 EURO

1.4.3. Registration of the Competitors

- Registration of competitors, coaches, VIPs, officials and supporters will be coordinated by All Europe Taekwon-Do Federation and must be registered for event through ITF-ONLINE.

1.5 Venue

The competition will be held at “Skenderija sports center” Sarajevo, multifunctional Sports Hall, address:

„Skenderija sports center” Sarajevo has four (4) halls. The main hall named "Mirza Delibašić" is a multipurpose space of 10,900 m², which depending on the type of program can accommodate from 1,500 to 15,000 spectators.

- The dimensions of the hall are 66 x 44m
- The dimensions of the floor are 60 x 40m.

NOTE: There will be available an extra hall to athletes for warming up.

1.6 How to reach Sarajevo

- **SARAJEVO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

Upon delegations request Organizer can provide transport airport Sarajevo to hotel and back at cost of 10,00 € per person. From and to Tuzla airport is 40 € per person.

1.7 Accommodation

- The participants will be accommodated in 3 and 4 stars hotels with wide offers.
- Prices include half board per person for the selected package.
- Participants can have lunch in the hall at affordable prices.
- Hotel services start on the day of arrival with a dinner and end with a breakfast on the day of departure. Because we have a limited number of single rooms, we ask that you turn to the organizer in time for coordination with the Hotels.
- Prices below are valid until August 10th 2019, after this date the organiser cannot guarantee for the same prices.
- If the hotel is located less than 2 km from the sports hall transport from the hotel to the hall will not be enabled.*

HOTEL - 3* :

- Single Room – 75 euro/person/night
- Double Room – 60 euro/person/night
- Triple Room – 50 euro/person/night

Note: Prices include HALF BOARD (breakfast and dinner in the hotel), free parking for the vehicles. transportation from hotel to sports hall and back. The number of available rooms is limited. Only early booking will guarantee accommodation.

HOTEL – 4*:

- Single Room – 95 euro/person/night
- Double Room – 75 euro/person/night

Note: Prices include HALF BOARD (breakfast and dinner in the hotel), swimming pool, fitness gym, sauna.

HOTEL– 5* :

- Single Room – 105 euro/person/night
- Double Room – 85 euro/person/night

1.7.1 Accommodation reservations and payment deadlines

To make a successful booking for a Hotel please follow these steps:

Step one: Fill out and send back to the Organising Committee's e-mail: info.itfec2019@gmail.com the „APPENDIX 2“ before or on 10th August 2019. After this the Organising Committee will contact the responsible person in each country to confirm the preliminary booking.

The 'Accommodation form' must reach the organising committee at the latest on 20th August 2019. After this date the organiser cannot guarantee places in the hotel or the above mentioned prices.

Step two:

- 50 % prepayment of total accommodation cost must be made by August 20th 2019.
- The rest of the amount including small corrections must be sent by September 24th 2019
- A small corrections in the numbers of attendees can be considered, if the difference in numbers is 10 % at most. In case it is higher than 10%, then the Organising Committee can not guarantee accommodation at the same hotels and/or prices.

Please note that the number of 3 stars hotel accommodation is limited and only the early booking can guarantee you accommodation of the preferred type.

3. RULES

- The competition will be held according to the official ITF Tournament Rules.

4. REQUIREMENTS

4.1 Umpires

- The Organizing Committee will cover full board accommodation (no drinks included) for 7 days / 6 nights from Tuesday, 8th October, 2019 to Monday, 14th October, 2019 for maximum of 50 umpires.
- Umpires will be accommodated in twin/double (2 persons) rooms.
- Where an Umpire is sharing accommodation, the guest will need to pay the accommodation rate of € 85,00 per day.
- Single rooms are not available therefore Umpires wishing to stay alone shall be paying an extra fee of € 50,00 per day.
- Umpires not selected, but wishing to participate and approved by the AETF Tournament & Umpire Committee, must cover their hotel accommodation according to above mentioned arrangements and will not receive any expense reimbursement by AETF.
- Umpires must attend the Umpire meeting on Wednesday, October 9, 2019 from 15.00-17.30 hours at Hotel HOLIDAY *****.



- Umpires not present at the mentioned umpire meeting will be removed from the umpire list shall pay their own accommodation expenses.
- Umpires will wear the dress requirements as laid down in the ITF Umpire rules.

Umpires wishing to be selected for the European Championships 2019, must complete (with approval of National Association) the 2019 UMPIRE APPLICATION FORM available under the link <https://goo.gl/forms/P81VxD8CEdy8379s1> on or before 20th August 2019.

4.2 Coaches

- At least 1 coach from participating country must attend the official on Wednesday October 9, 2019 from 17.30 hours at Hotel HOLIDAY ****.
- Must wear either a training suit or a T-shirt and pants and running shoes while coaching. Only one (1) coach of a country is allowed entering the coaching zone at the same time. Only a coach can present an official protest.

4.3 Competitors

4.3.1 Competitor information

Individual entry fee: 100,00 € per competitor (including for competitors competing only in Team disciplines);

Team entry fee: 50,00 € per team. Entry fees include:

- ID card, which is mandatory for the Tournament as an official document for identifying competitors, coaches, umpires and staff. The card is acquired when payment for the accommodation done through the Organizing Committee of the Tournament and is valid for:
 - Free entrance to the sports hall,
 - Transport from the hotels to the sports hall (if the hotel is more than 2 km away from the hall)
 - Entry to the swimming-pool, sauna and fitness in hotels (4* hotel)
 - Medical assistance during the competition (for competitors).

The competitor's entry fee can be paid in CASH and in EUROS at the registration of competitors or can be transferred electronically and must be cleared by 24th of September 2019 to the AETF Bank Account.

Please remember to pay the transfer costs from your side. If the AETF has to pay for the transfer costs then you will need to pay this back upon arrival. Credit cards and other forms of payment will not be accepted.

4.3.2 Insurance

- The organizing Committee will not be responsible for any possible injuries caused during the competition. All competitors must have full insurance coverage by their own organization/country.

4.3.3 Equipment

- All competitors must wear official dobok and protection gear currently approved by the ITF.
- All competitors must wear full set of blue or red protection gear according to the draw.
- Awarding dress code – no competitors will be admitted to awarding ceremony wearing shorts, casual pants, flip flops or bare footed.

4.3.4 Divisions

- The championships will be for Junior and Senior competitors.
- Juniors must be 14 years old on the first day of the competition.
- Competitors born in the year 2005 must participate as Juniors.
- Competitors born in 2000 or before are Seniors.
- Competitors born in 2001 participate as Juniors or Seniors.



5. FLAG AND NATIONAL ANTHEM

Each participating country must bring a flag (size 90 X 130 cm) for the Opening Ceremony. The national anthem must be sent as audio file at any format available to: info.itfec2019@gmail.com
